[University of Pittsburgh Medical Center \(UPMC\)](#) and [CommonSpirit Health](#) have signed a definitive agreement to transfer ownership of [Trinity Health System](#), including Trinity West, Trinity East, Trinity St. Clairsville Neighborhood Hospital, Trinity Twin City Medical Center, and associated clinics and residency programs, to UPMC. The transaction is expected to be completed in Fall 2026, pending regulatory review and customary closing conditions.

While our hospital systems may have different histories, we have always shared a common vision for our training programs. UPMC Medical Education looks forward to continuing that mission in training our future generations of physicians to care for our communities.

Those applying to Trinity Health System's Emergency Medicine residency program must apply through the Residency Centralized Application Service (ResidencyCAS). Those applying to Trinity Health System's Internal Medicine residency program must apply through the Electronic Residency Application Service (ERAS). Until the transfer of ownership is effective, Trinity Health System's salary structure, benefits, contract template and policies will apply to residents accepted into those programs.

Following the transfer, UPMC Medical Education's contract template, policies and benefits will apply to the Trinity residency programs.
